Community Conversations

Leading up to this year's important election, we hosted over 30 trustbuilding events, connecting Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, and Michigan community members to their election officials and experts to discuss how elections work and educate about election law.









Continuing Legal Education

Our legal education seminars cumulatively attracted upward of 2,700 attorneys. Additionally, over 400 pages of first of its kind legal analysis were drafted for responses by state leadership to crises on Election Day and in the post-election period. The American Bar Association awarded KOR the "Unsung Hero of Democracy" award for our work to protect democracy and the rule of law.and experts to discuss how elections work and educate about election law.











FINANCIAL SUMMARY 2024 Revenue 2024 Expenditures
